




- David Wahl has designed this "Exploding" pendant lamp for IKEA's Collection 2014.
- He was inspired by science fictions and video games.
- It already appears to be the highlight piece and an IKEA bestseller.
- Its unique design is not only functional, it's also very playful and it is proving popular amongst adults and children alike, plus it has a price tag of just £50 (\$70/€50)!
- This lamp is on sale in IKEA from the first of April 2014.

## Lamp and light

- This lamp is transformed from a glowing fissured sphere to a complex mass of suspended panel by pulling on a simple drowstring.
- This gives the user a multitude of different **light level** in between thanks to the trasformative nature of the lamp in itself serves to dim it, while before to give this effect need to buy a luxury dimmer switches.
- The outer panels are composed of white polypropylene plastic but the rods on which they're attached are available in two different colors: turquoise or orange.



## LED and orange

- Given that LED light tend to give out a whiter (some say colder) light than traditional bulbs, so it's better opt for the orange color option to make the light appear warmer.
- This lamp use LED lights which use
   85% less energy than incandescent bulbs and also lasting a lot longer.
